- Follows and executes detailed instructions for proper implementation of technical specifications
- Practices industry-standard coding conventions, including documenting code with comments, to develop applications
- Performs unit and regression testing during development of applications
- Promptly informs team leadership of issues or problems that may impact project work or schedules
- Meets pre-determined project and task deadlines
- Researches technical problems and suggests improvements for web applications
- Analyzes and integrates new web products/technologies with existing web applications to improve the web design and application functionality
- Demonstrates a commitment to providing quality products in a timely manner
